		<i>School Day</i> 8:00 am to 2:45 pm, Monday–Thursday 8:00 am to 1:30 pm, Friday	
Early Childhood	3 to 6 years	<i>Half Day</i> 8:00 am to 12:15 pm, Monday - Friday	Children who turn 3 by June 1 st of attendance year. Children should be in the process of toilet training.
		<i>School Day</i> 8:00 am to 2:45 pm, Monday–Thursday 8:00 am to 1:30 pm, Friday	Children who turn 3 by June 1 st of attendance year. Children must be fully independent with toileting for admission to the School Day EC program.
Elementary	Lower Elementary 6 – 9 years	<i>School Day</i> 8:00 am to 2:45 pm, Monday–Thursday 8:00 am to 1:30 pm, Friday	Students should have at least one year prior of Montessori education. In some cases, children who are considered successful candidates for the Montessori environment may be considered for entry at the 6-year-old level.
	Upper Elementary 9 – 12 years		
Adolescent	12 – 14 years	<i>School Day</i> 8:00 am to 2:45 pm, Monday–Thursday 8:00 am to 1:30 pm, Friday	Students must have been in Montessori education prior to age 12 for admission with priority consideration given to currently enrolled MSL students.
Extended Care	Generally, at least 4 years old, younger than 4 only by approval	<i>After School</i> 2:45 pm – 6:00 pm	Admission to the extended care program is based upon the child's readiness for the longer school day. If it is determined that extended care negatively impacts a child's school experience, parents will be asked to make other arrangements for their child for the after-school period. Arrangements for arrival before school must be made in advance by contacting the Director.
